From the Trustees:

The Trustees want to thank you all for your giving to the church this fiscal year. Currently the numbers are in a positive place compared to past years and that is because giving is up. We are so encouraged by where we stand at the moment and hope through the continued giving to remain steady financially for the remainder of the year.

Part of our success with the budget has to do with in kind giving purchases for Fellowship Hour and other disposable material needs. If you have given we are so appreciative and if you have an interest in doing so, there is a board outside of the sanctuary with needed items. The Trustees with the help of others are compiling a list of items so we can better maintain our supply. One current need is 8 to 10 oz. coffee cups for Fellowship Hour. Thanks again to all those who have graciously given items and please know any help going forward is appreciated.

It is hot out there (and sometimes in the church) at the moment and the fans in the sanctuary have been being adjusted recently to maximize their functional use. At the current moment we are still making tweaks, but hope those will be completed in the near future to better help us all stay a bit cooler as we worship.

In late July, our annual fire inspection was conducted. There are a few needs to be addressed including adjusting some doors and installing carbon monoxide detectors which will be done in the coming weeks. We were additionally instructed that there are a few doors including the white ones going into the vestry and the wooden ones going into Fellowship Hall that need to remain closed as often as possible. This may cause a bit of an inconvenience with our traffic pattern on Sunday but hopefully we can all work together to make the best of this new situation. The good news is that these are all fairly minor fixes at minimal cost and we are approved to assemble for the coming year.

603 Pest has been helping us curtail the extra visitors to our building on a quarterly basis. Our most recent visit in early August was very positive and it appears that some of the problem spots are faring better. We truly appreciate their help in resolving these issues both inside and outside of our building.

In July the Trustees accepted the resignation of Heather Bridges for the position of Administrative Assistant and Choir Director. The Trustees worked with the Music Committee to formulate a plan on moving forward and it was decided that our great accompanist, Jon Abrams, will assume some additional duties along with further compensation for those. It was a great collaboration of the two groups to secure a positive path ahead and we look forward to what comes next for our music ministry.

We are also currently putting the final touches on an ad for an administrative assistant. It is our hope to be actively searching for this position in the near future. If you know of someone who is not a member of our church and has administrative skills and is interested in part time employment of 10 hours a week, please have them submit a resume, letter of interest and 3 letters of recommendation to office@hooksettucc.org.


